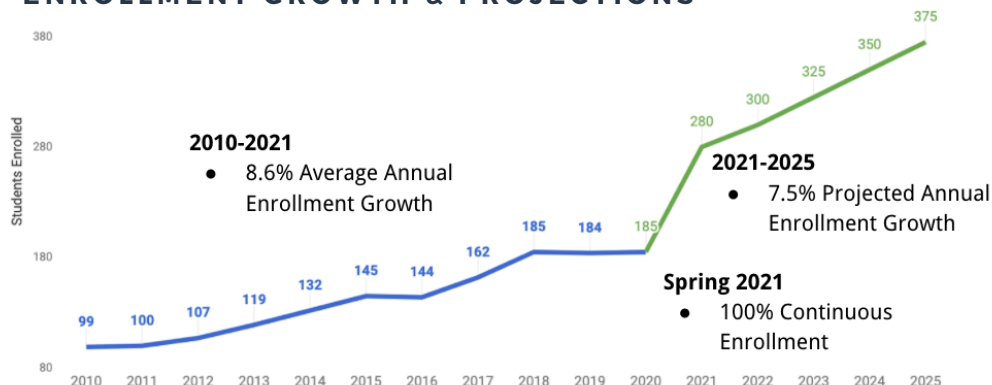

Over the next five years, as our projected enrollment growth is realized and construction funds are raised through our capital campaign, ownership of the property will be transferred to CHA at no cost.
